Windows Defender is free and excellent.

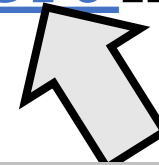
Internet providers – Orcon, Clear, Xtra, 2 degrees

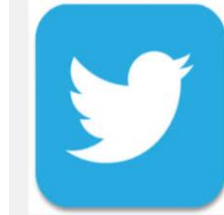

16 mixed characters

3 + 1 backup rule

1. **Computer hard drive**
2. **Portable device: Flash Drive “labile”**

CD Optical drive
